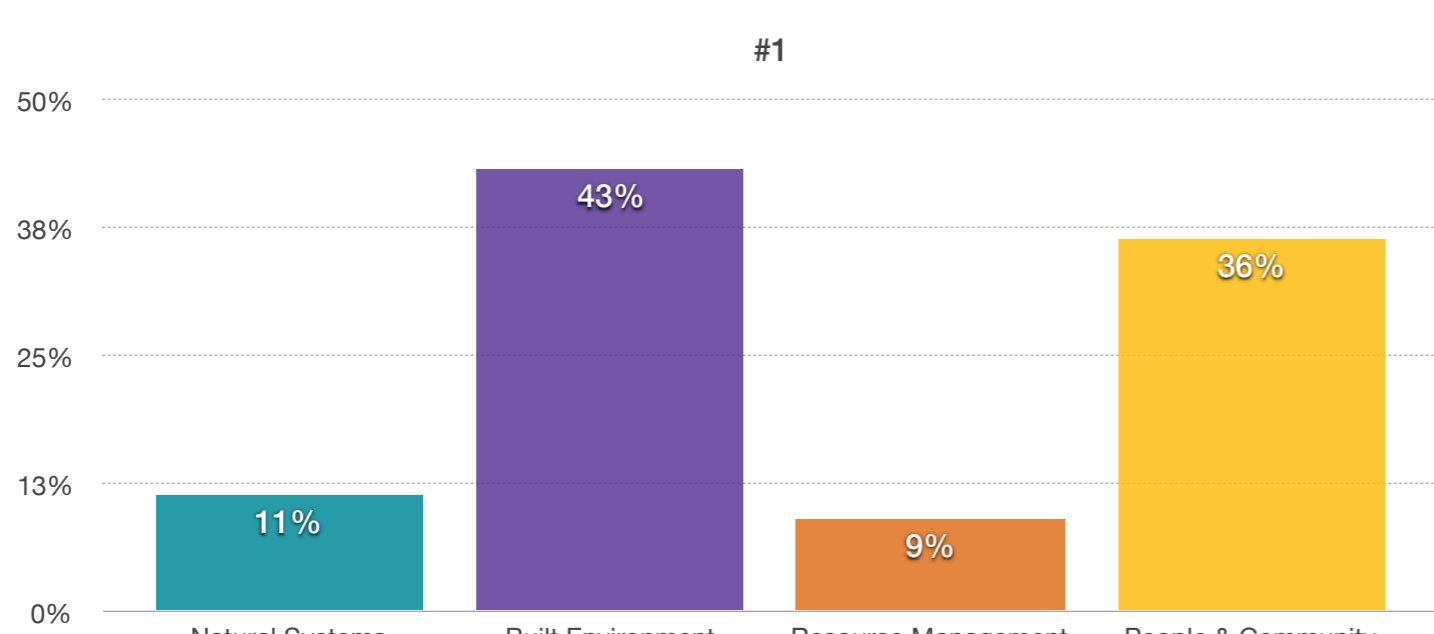


Question 1: Which Issue Should be the Second Priority?

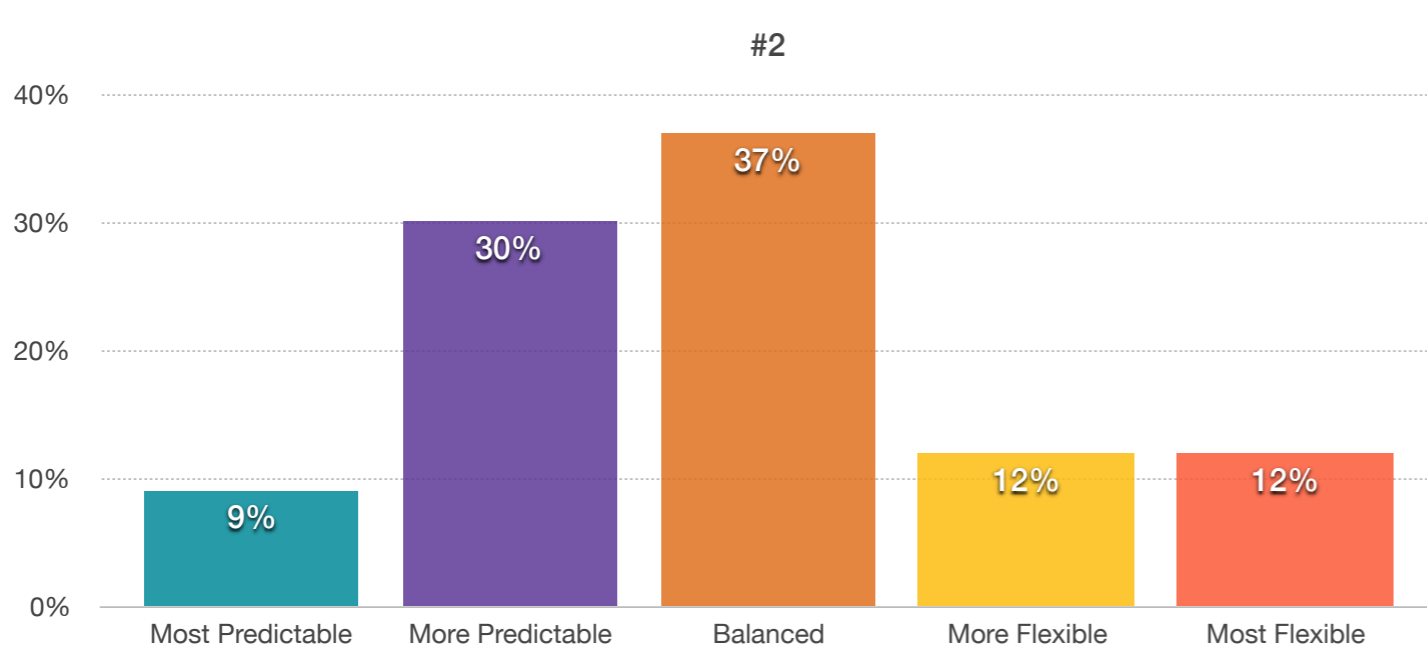

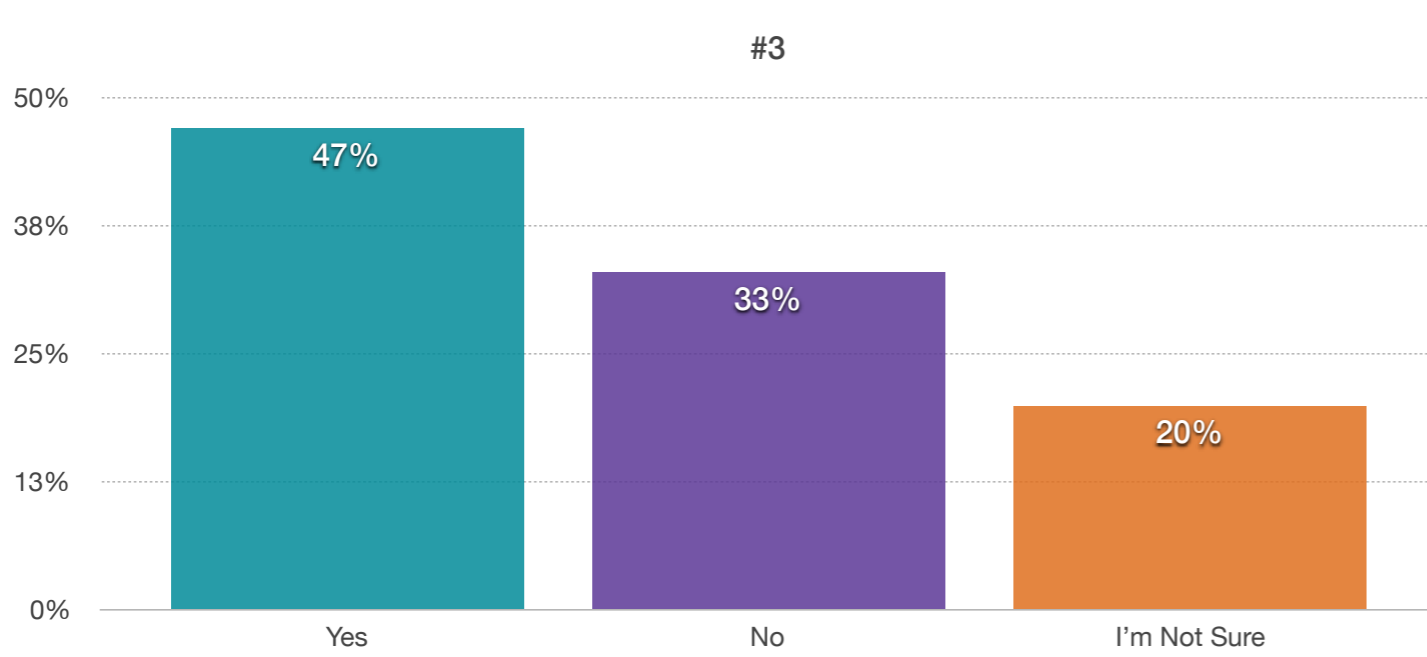

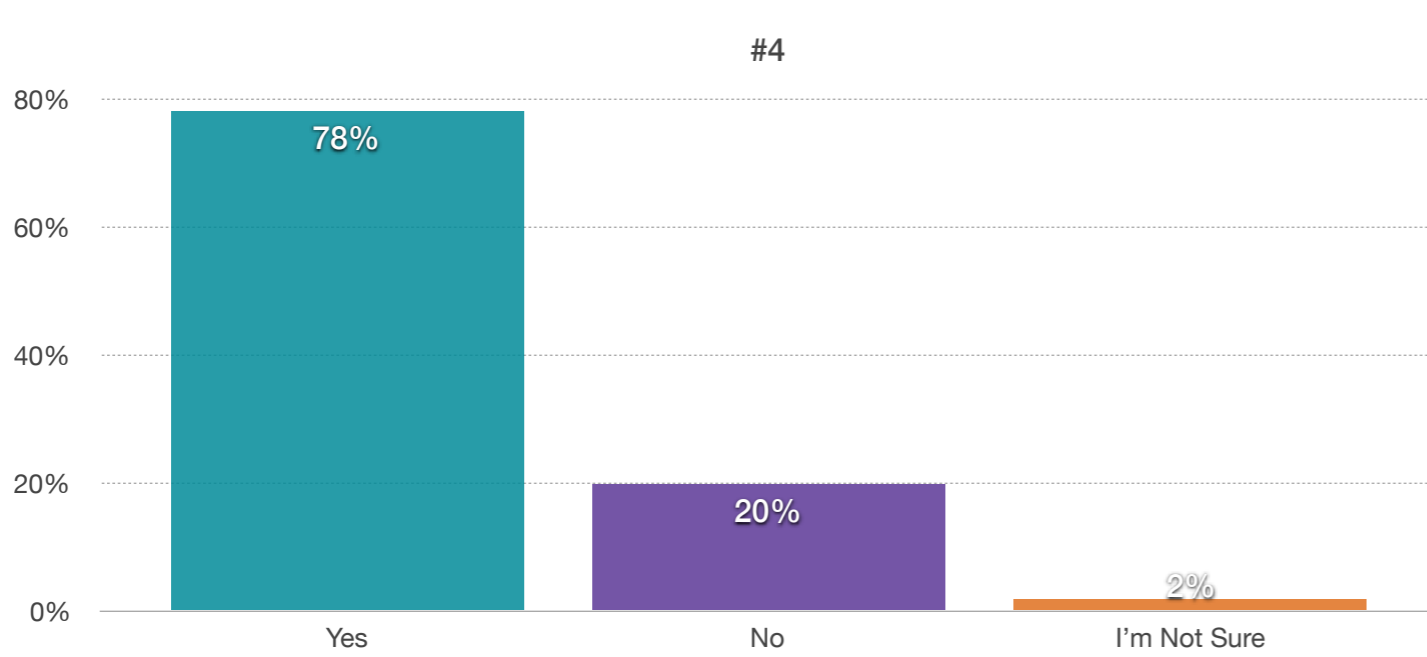

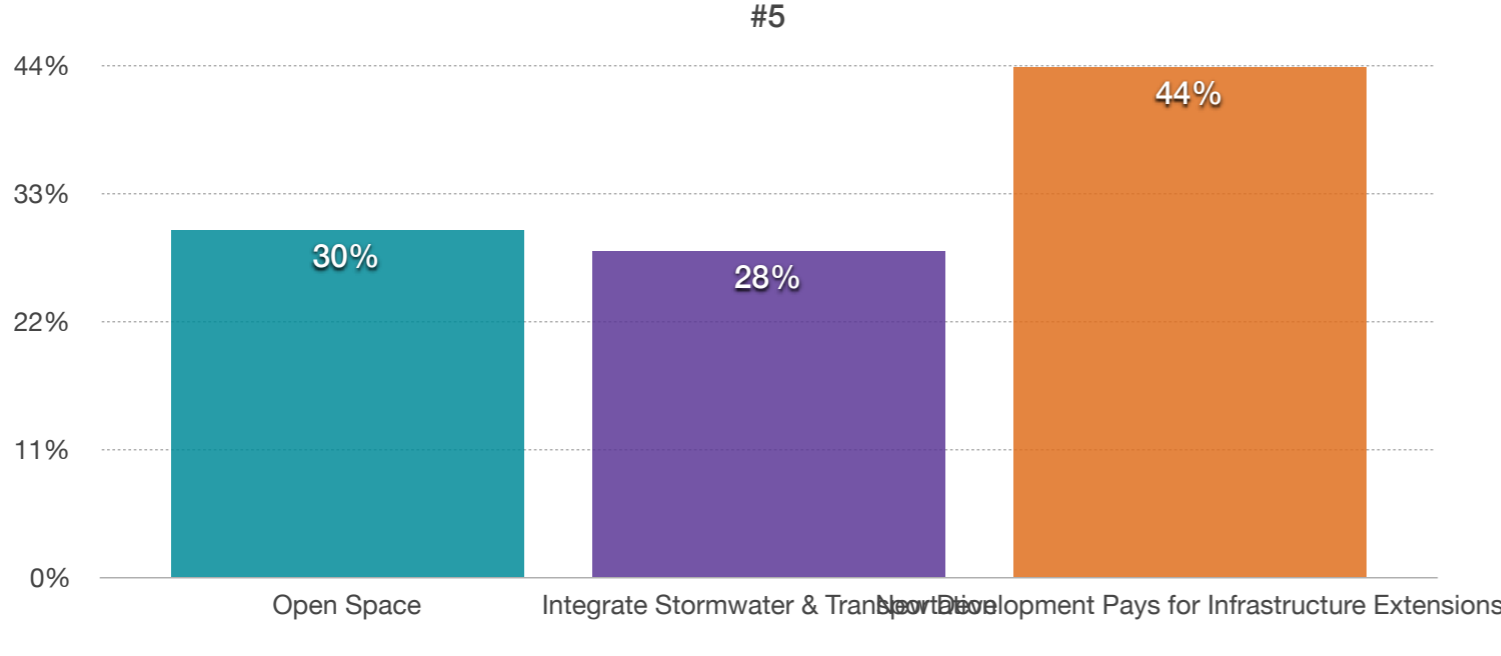

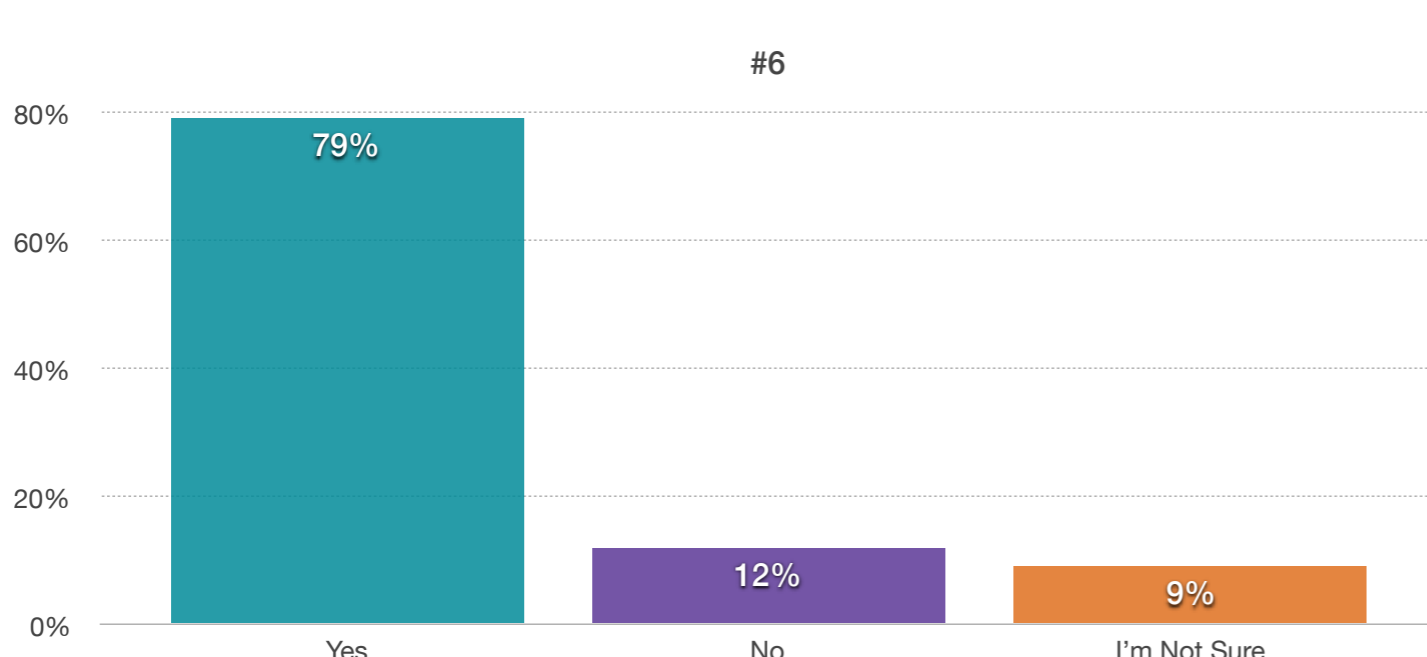
